1. Apologies:  
Apologies were received from Mrs A Starkey and Mr S Rhodes.
2. Minutes of Previous Meeting  
The minutes of the meeting held 29 January 2020 were agreed and signed as a true record.
3. Declarations of Interest  
There were no declarations of interest.
4. Planning Applications to be Considered  
20/02018/PLF – Eastgate House, East Gate, Rudston – installation of new windows to side and installation of roof light to front.  
  
It was agreed that a ‘no objection’ comment be submitted.
5. Accounts  
The Year End accounts were received and approved by the members.
6. Vacation of Office  
With regard to the email received from Mathew Buckley, Head of Legal and Democratic Services at East Riding of Yorkshire Council, it was agreed to plan a provisional meeting to be held in around 3 months.
7. Date and Time of Next Meeting

Any Other Business

- The vacancy for a councillor had received one application from Mr Richard Todd who was invited to attend the meeting to put forward his reasons for applying for the role. Mr Todd then vacated the meeting area whilst the Council discussed. All were in favour of co-opting Mr Todd as a new member of the Parish Council.
- Mr Simmonds raised the issue of the break-in at the village store to discuss if ANPR (Automatic Number Plate Recognition) cameras would be of benefit to trace the culprits. Mr Simmonds would speak to Diane and advise she speak direct with the Police.
- Mr Simmonds enquired about how the money received from Centrica for the Caythorpe Fund should be used. Any suggestions should be sent to the Clerk.
- Mr Wood raised an issue with the Defibrillator as at present the pads are to be changed more regularly and a further supply is required. The Clerk is to contact Mrs Starkey who may have some pads, and to also ask how many more should be ordered.
- Mr Smallwood enquired about changing any remaining street lights that are not LED over to LED. The Clerk is to enquire with the supplier what the cost would be for this.
- Mr Smallwood enquired about the gates on Shady Lane. 2 of the 3 have been modernised, but the third is still in a state of disrepair. The Clerk is to identify ownership of the gate on the map on the council website and then make enquiries with the owner about a replacement.
- Mr Overfield advised that the playing field fence needs maintaining or replacing. Mr Simmonds and Mr Wood are to raise the issue with Stewart Harrison.
